Abstract Submission Guidelines

- Poster and paper presentation may include original research or case report.
- Kindly specify the category (paper / poster) while submitting the abstract.
- The abstract should not exceed 300 word limit excluding title and references.
- Font should be Times New Roman, Size-12, with single line spacing and title should be in bold.
- For original research, the abstract should be structured and organised under following headings: Introduction, Objectives, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusions and References.
- Graphs, tables, and images should not be included in the abstract.
- Mode of oral presentation will be Microsoft Power Point with time limit of maximum 8 minutes (6 mins for presentation and 2 mins for discussion).
- Time limit for poster presentation is 5 minutes. (3 mins for presentation and 2 mins for discussion).
- The poster size should be 2.5feet (height) x 4feet (width). Landscape orientation
- All delegates opting for poster presentation are to mail the E- poster of their presentation to iafmesic2025@gmail.com
- All delegates are advised to print their own posters for presentation at the conference in the prescribed dimensions.
- If the delegates require assistance in printing of poster the same can be requested through email and poster will be printed and charged as per actuals to be incurred.
- Please upload the abstract via Google Form (Available on the Website) as either a Word document or PDF
- It is advised to keep minimum font size as follows: Title: 20, Subtitle: 18 and Text: 16.
- Last date for abstract submission in 15th December 2024.
- All abstracts will be reviewed by the committee and the presenting author will be informed via email regarding acceptance/rejection of their abstracts.




