Hon'ble Sir,

A meeting of IAFM was held on 4th Dec. in which it was decided to approach BOG MCI by sending a memorandum (Copy attached). The salient points for consideration to BOG are as follows:

Editor:

Dr. Mukesh Yadav

- The earlier regulation dt. 30 Mar 1999 reg staff pertaining to Forensic Medicine must be restored.
- The teaching hours need be increased to 200 hours than that of existing 100 hours.
- There is need to restructure the curriculum of MBBS for the subject of Forensic Medicine & Toxicology and increase the marks allocation from 100 to 200.
- One month training in Forensic Medicine must be made compulsory during Internship, instead of elective.
- Every district headquarter should have designated forensic medicine expert as In-charge of all medico-legal services of concerned district.


