A meeting of IAFM was held on 4th Dec. in which it was decided to approach BOG MCI by sending a memorandum (Copy attached). The salient points

for consideration to BOG are as follows:

a)The earlier regulation dt. 30 Mar 1999 reg staff pertaining to Forensic

Medicine must be restored.

b) The teaching hours need be increased to 200 hours than that of existing

c)There is need to restructure the curriculum of MBBS for the subject of Forensic Medicine & Toxicology and increase the marks allocation from

100 to 200.

d)One month training in Forensic Medicine must be made compulsory

during Internship, instead of elective.

e)Every district headquarter should have designated forensic medicine expert as In-charge of all medico-legal services of concerned district.

We are highly thankful to the BOG MCI for giving patient hearing to our just demands & agreeing in principle. It is hoped that BOG will immediately take

appropriate steps on above demands of the forensic tracernity
