**Agenda Item No.2: Confirmation of Previous Minutes of the Annual General Body Meeting held on 30/04/202 at SGPGI Medical College, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh in physical mode. The General Secretary informed the members that entire minutes are uploaded on official website of IAFM along with the notice of the AGBM.**

The minutes were read and ask for suggestion. If any.

Dr C.B.Jani raised an objection regarding agenda item no 12 mentioned in the minutes of the meeting held on 30/04/202 at SGPGI Medical College, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh. He informed that part second of the agenda cannot become part of this minutes as the activity of co-opting a member is done later on in the first meeting of the newly elected governing council. Discussion took place and it was concluded that suggestion of Dr Jani is accepted on technically grounds. Hence it was decided that the second part will be deleted and the new minutes will be uploaded after correction.

Another issue was raised by Dr C B Jani seeking clarification how the co-opted members are decided. 

### AWARDS: Awards from IAFM at National Conference

General Secretary Dr Manish Kumath informed that We managed to frame guidelines for the different awards conferred under IAFM. With great efforts of the executive committee members we managed to frame guidelines regarding hosting symposium/ seminars / webinars and any other academic activity under banner of IAFM. The guidelines were made in such a flexible way that it will promote our members to conduct more and more academic activities. It took continuous efforts of the committee members in preparing these guidelines. I would like to thank my council member for their efforts and success. The guidelines of both the awards and the concerned academic activity will be uploaded on the website once it is approved by the GBM. He presented the guidelines prepared which are as follows.

After preliminary discussion the following point system criteria was framed for screening and awarding the applications/nominations:

1. Minimum age for award of fellowship will be 45 years as on 31 Dec. of that year.
2. The applicant should be a life member of IAFM with a minimum period of 15 years. He will be provided 15 points for his association with IAFM and as the number of years of association with IFAM increases; the points will increase with a sealing of 20 points as maximum.
3. He should have attended at least 10 IAFM annual conferences for which he will be provided 10 points. Afterwards for every next conference attended he will be awarded one point with a maximum sealing of 15 points.
4. He should have published at least 5 papers in the JIAFM and will be provided with 5 marks for the same which will go on increasing with each paper with a sealing of 10 marks. Those who had not if the applicant has published a book along with the papers, he/she will be provided with additional 5 points for this work. The contribution to every chapter will have 1 point with a ceiling of 5 points.

5. If the applicant has organized IAFM conference then he will be provided with 15 marks as organizing chairperson and 10 points as an organizing secretary. The Co/Joint Org Secretary will be given 5 points. For any other zonal activity of IAFM, he will be provided with 5 points. The total ceiling under this heading will be 20 points.

6.If the applicant has served the IAFM governing council in the key post ie President/ Vice President /Secretary/Joint Secretary/Treasurer/Editor/Joint Editor; he will be given 10 points each for the number of terms he has served. For serving on the Executive Member post he will be provided with 5 points for each tenure. The sealing for both the above services to the council will be 25 points.

7.If the applicant has presented paper(s) in the conference; then he will be provided with 1 point for each presentation with sealing of 5 points, 5 points for guest speaker and 2 points for chairing/co-chairing a session (Sealing for both will be 10 points). The above criteria will not be bifurcated into 3 different criteria. All will be considered as one and will have a sealing of 20 points.

8.Delivering an oration in the conference will provide the applicant 10 points.


Dr Aditya Sharma raised an objection that why publish in JIAFM is mandatory. He told that one should be allowed to publish in any journal. It was clarified by Dr.Adarsh that publication in the JIAFM is given importance as it shows contribution to the academy.


The guidelines were approved by the General body to be uploaded on the IAFM website.

Dr Manish Kumath , General secretary than informed that though the above mentioned decision was taken in the executive committee meeting held at Hyderabad but nothing is endorsed in the General body meeting minutes of the Hyderabad conference held in 2020. Subsequently the above mentioned awards were declared in the next GBM in 2021 at cuttack conference but the source of funds from which many the awards to be conferred was still not clear. Dr C B Jani said that all the awards should be for the members of the IAFM only and raised an objection that in 2022 non IAFM members were also awarded.


On this Dr Pankaj requested that some awards should be kept for non iafm members also and all those who participate in such category should be promoted to take IAFM membership.


